





NET ZERO POLICY

Ventient Energy is committed to providing renewable energy to secure a sustainable future for people and the planet. This includes an ambitious inorganic growth strategy which will contribute significantly to the expansion of the low carbon economy.

Ventient is doing everything possible to contribute to a net zero future, as per the commitments outlined below. The company fully intends to set a net zero target at the earliest point possible, which will be wholly evidenced by a robust roadmap and science-based action plan.

This policy is aligned with best practice, as defined by the internationally recognised GHG Protocol. Ventient is committed to adhering to the highest standards in emissions reporting and is dedicated to full transparency across GHG emissions reporting and target setting.

To support this policy, Ventient:

- Calculates an annual companywide GHG emissions inventory in accordance with the GHG Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard (inclusive of scope 1, scope 2 and material scope 3 GHG emissions and the seven GHGs covered by the Kyoto Protocol).
- Integrates newly acquired assets into the GHG emissions inventory within 6-months of acquisition.
- Rebaselines the GHG emissions inventory after periods of significant inorganic growth.
- Analyses the GHG emissions inventory annually to identify the main GHG emissions drivers and feasible GHG emissions reduction opportunities.

- Sets actionable GHG emissions reduction objectives on drivers under the company's control.
- Updates policies and processes to reduce GHG emissions when feasible reduction opportunities are identified.
- Raises internal and external stakeholder awareness through education on GHG emissions.
- Reevaluates the ability to set a net zero target regularly as the growth strategy evolves.
